

Vanuatu: Volcano - Distances from Lombenben on Ambae


Map shows distances from the volcano including the 6.5km zone where villages within the zone are most at risk from airborne rocks and volcanic gases.

People (approximately 6,000 of the 10,000 total island population) to the north and south of the island are being moved to the east and west ends of the island.

There is a likelihood that crops may be affected by acid rain.
