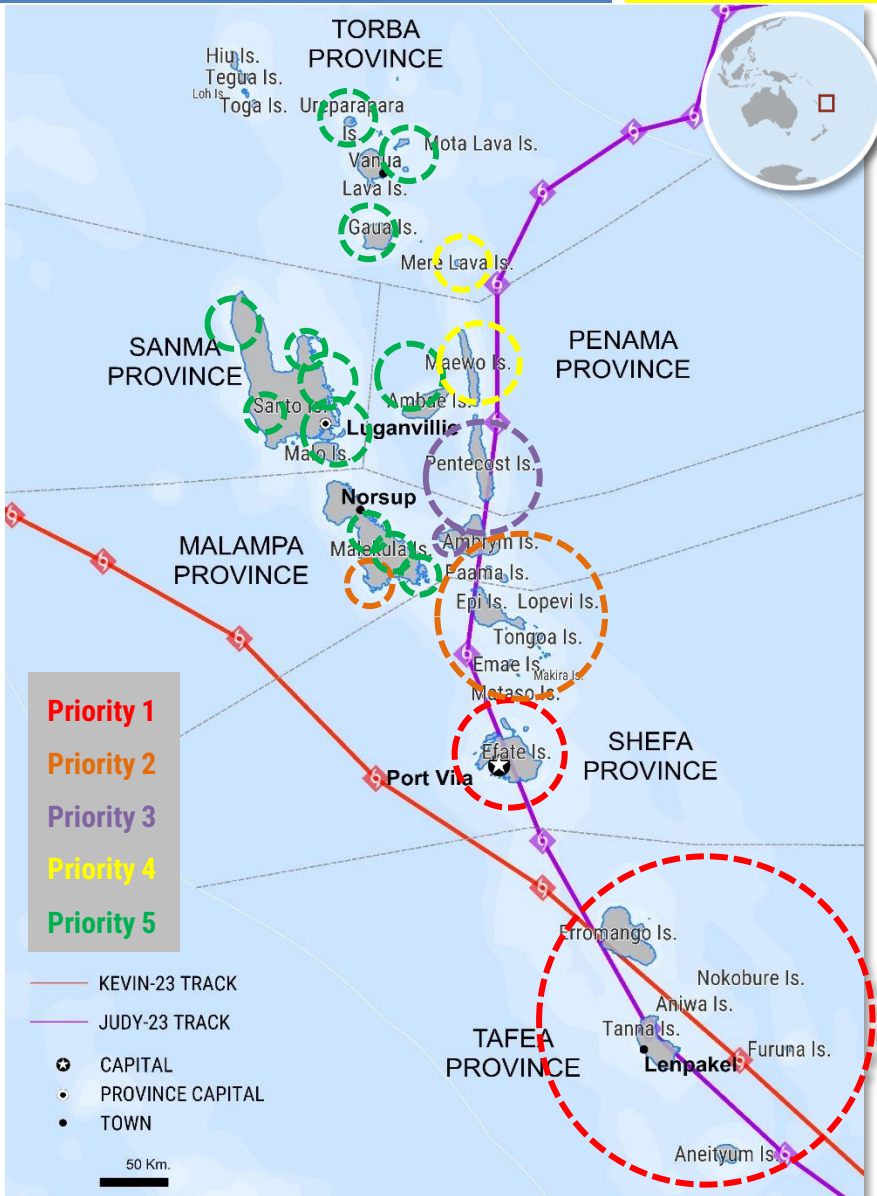

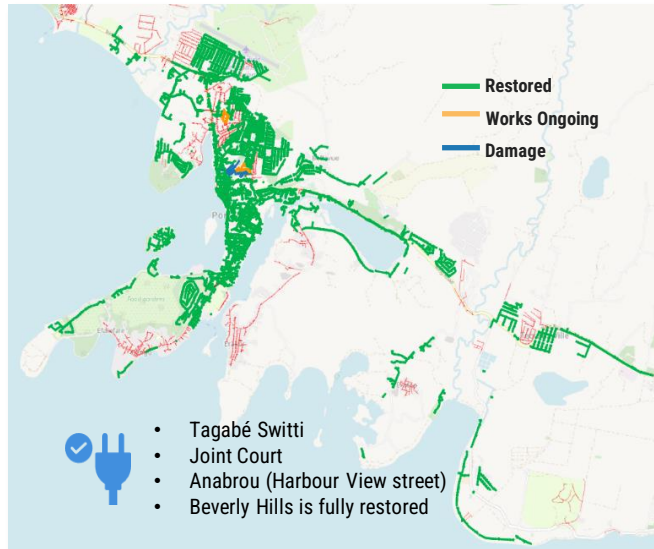

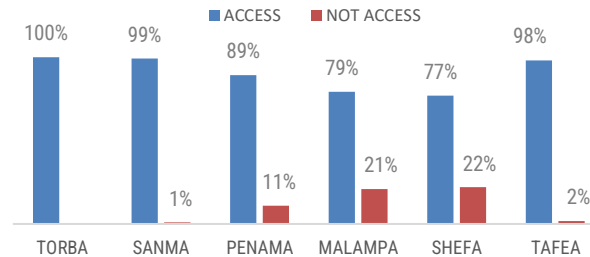


SHEPHERDS ISLAND DISTRIBUTION [20 March 2023]

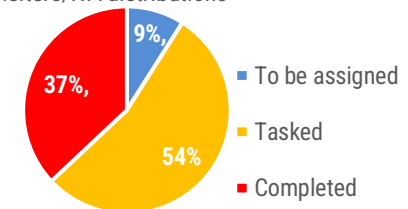

Fiji Government supplies

1000 Fiji rations Bucket

Consist of:

- 4kg of rice
- 2kg of sugar
- 4kg of yellow split peas
- 4 cans of mackerel
- 1 medium size bottle of cooking oil



Distribution of Food Ration per Area Council:

(Bags of Rice Distributed 17th - 19th March)

- North Efate Area Council - **749HH**
- North- West Area Council - **667HH**
- Southern Ward Distribution - **578HH**
- Tanvasoko Area Council- **136 HH**
- Emau Area Council- **210 HH**
- East Efate Area Council- **832HH**
- **50659 of vegetable seeds**, including the final food distribution to the evacuation Centre at Forari.
Evacuation Centre received **15 Ctn tuna**, **15 Ctn water** and **15 bag rice**
