VMGD Manaro Volcano Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Volcano Activity Level remains in Level 3 - High emission of ashfall in July - Latest ashfall emission last week - Chances of the activity to stop is really low - Level 1 of volcano activity would be the safest to move back to island. - Current signs that volcanic activity is building up again in the magmatic chamber; each new activity is more intense that the previous. 	<p>Recommendation: multi-sector community awareness to affected communities to explain the volcano situation</p> <p>While planning, clusters need to always have a Plan A and B considering the calculated/projected risks that the volcano may incur.</p> <p>Clear messaging on what will happen after SOE.</p> <p>Clusters need integrate messaging into their planning</p>
Long term plan for Maewo	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Short-term budgets are already received by the NDMO, however, there is need for intermediate and long-term plans. - Since the SOE will end soon, the intermediate and long-term budgets should come out from each clusters budget. - The plans will only concentrate on Maewo, however, each clusters normal operational budget should consider increasing services in Santo, Ambae and Pentecost. 	<p>Short-term (gaps from the previous plan), intermediate and long-term plans to be submitted by Friday 14th September 2018.</p> <p>Integrate messaging (how to educate people of Ambae on Volcano activity) into plans. The messaging should help them to decide whether moving back to Ambae after the SOE is a best option or not.</p>
Maewo Land update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - See attached presentation (slide 4 & 5) 	<p>Gender & Protection can work with NDMO and other clusters to raise awareness in evacuation centers and host communities of child protection and children's rights to try and reduce the risk of child marriages as a result of displacement and customary adoption.</p>
