Gender and Protection Referral Card

If you meet a survivor of gender based violence...

- 1. Do not try to solve the problem yourself.
- 2. Use words that comfort to the survivor and show respect.
- 3. Inform the person that you can refer them to someone who may be able to
- advise or assist them. 4. Maintain confidentiality and respect their wishes.

Gender and Protection <u>Cluster</u>

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- 6. Always seek consent before referring to a support service, and if the survivor is highly vulnerable. offer to accompany them.
- 7. Listen but never judge, and don't record their personal data.



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
