Situation Update

- **Council of Ministers decision main points:**

- State of Emergency extended for a further 2 weeks
- NDMO & Penema Provincial Government to prepare a repatriation plan by next Thursday 19th October

Work completed yesterday

- MoE establish a working group on psycho-social support for students
- Shelter and WASH distributions in Luganville to evacuation centres including blankets, kitchen kits, tarpaulins, solar lights, hygiene kits
- Red Cross & NDMO support communities in Pentecost & Maewo with NFIs & food delivery.
- Food distribution to evacuation centres in Luganville
- NDMO & IOM Registrations of host families in Luganville. SMS used to communicate with host communities for registration. Registration teams departed for Pentecost & Maewo.
- NGOs continue to support government cluster system to deliver services
- G&P cluster have developed a case list and response strategies
