Instrument of Directions to Government Agencies relating to Tropical Cyclone Judy and Tropical Cyclone Kevin (Amendment)
Order No. 33 of 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by subsection 35(1) of the Disaster Risk Management Act No. 23 of 2019, I, the Honourable RALPH REGENVANU, Minister of Meteorology, Geological Hazards and Climate Change, on the advice of the National Disaster Committee, make the following Order.

AMENDMENTS OF THE INSTRUMENT OF DIRECTIONS OF GOVERNMENT AGENCIES RELATING TO TROPICAL CYCLONE JUDY AND TROPICAL CYCLONE KEVIN ORDER NO. 31 OF 2023

(b) foreign or national non-government organization and other individuals,

must be put into the public fund account held with the Ministry of Finance and Economic Management. The in-kind support received must be based on needs as approved by the National Disaster Management Office.

(11) The Ministry of Finance and Economic Management and Vanuatu National Provident Fund must ensure that the Vanuatu National Provident Fund Board meet and decide on a percentage to be paid from each members' fund to assist with members recovery from TC Judy and TC Kevin disaster."
